SUMMARY

The elected members of the Higher Council of the Ordre des géomètres-experts are present with public authorities and their partners to defend a transformative vision of the profession. The Ordre represents surveyors in dealings with public authorities, and drives a genuine development strategy for the profession. It is the profession's regulatory and strategic management body. Since the law n°46-942 of May 7 1946, its vocation has been to ensure discipline and the quality of service provided to consumers. The Order also guarantees compliance with the code of ethics and rules of the art that apply to each of its members. The body is supported by a Higher Council and 18 regional councils with legal personality.

Driving forward and sharing his vision

OGE's Executive Board has been meeting regularly with ministries and partners to share his vision of a profession that is transforming itself and serving the public interest.

In addition to supervision ministry (Housing, Sustainable Development), with which it maintains almost daily contact, OGE's ExBoard has met with all the French ministries in charge of many issues affecting the profession (make progress on the many issues affecting the profession (reform of land registration law, zero net land take, housing, reform of regulated professions, delimitation of road boundaries, gender equality, compliance, etc.), as well as with all related stakeholders and professionals like the notaries, mayors and chairmen of intercommunal bodies.

Characterized by its multi-disciplinary nature and the diversity of its missions, the geodetic surveyor profession must take its rightful place in the living environment sector. In line with its strategic plan, OGE intends to transform the profession to meet the challenges of the future. To
