#### SUMMARY

Cadastrals and systems for land administration and management remain integral to building sustainable and prosperous communities. FIG Commission 7 provides the global platform for advocating, creating and knowledge, and professionalizing the domain. This paper provides a snapshot of key recent developments influencing the field, and demonstrates how via Member Associations, Commission 7's 2023-26 is responding at the global level. This includes teams working on forwarding FELA, FFPLA, 3D land administration, LADM, AI and remote sensing, women's access to land, digitally transformed land management, land administration education, and sharing comparative cadastral data. Specific country cases are drawn upon to color the narrative, including relevant examples from the Netherlands, Moldova, Armenia, Indonesia, Rwanda, Chad, and Togo.

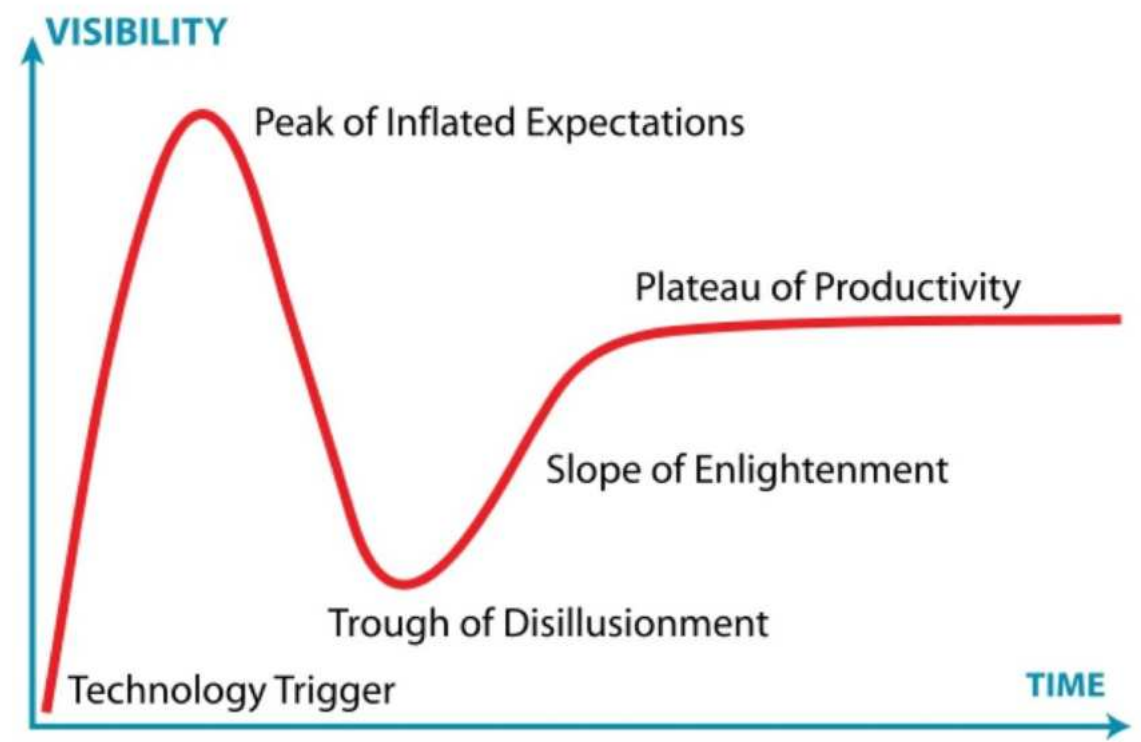

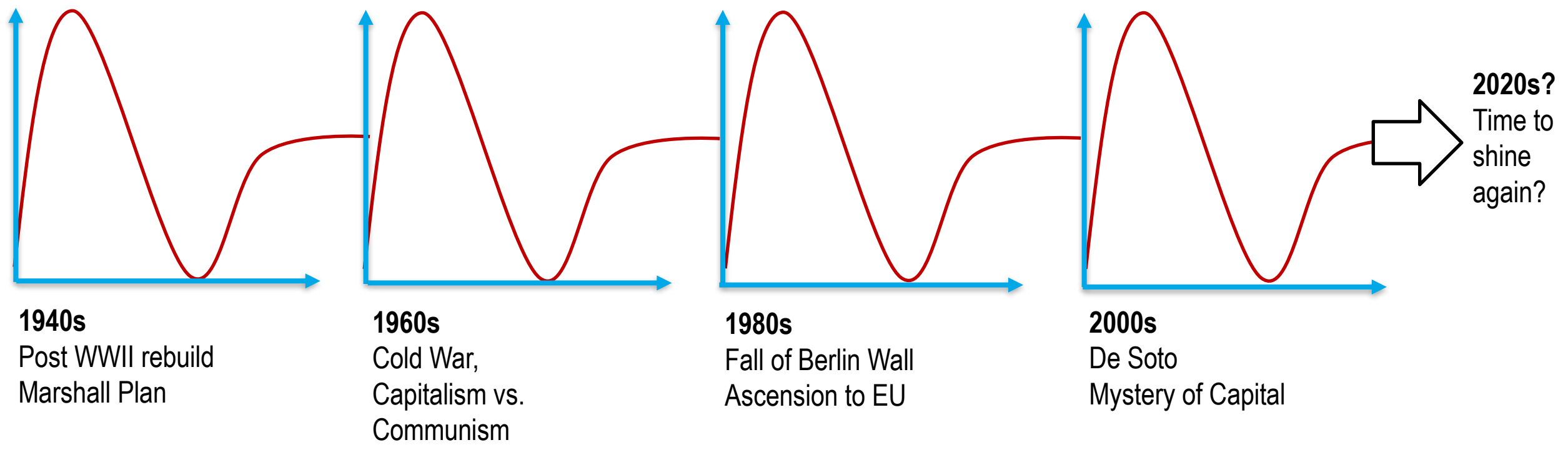

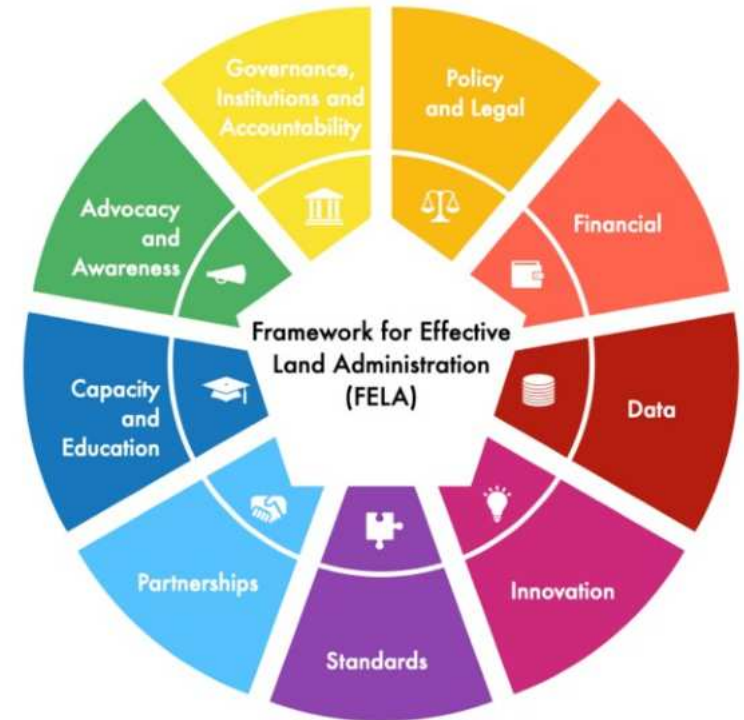


Figure 6: Nine Pathways of the Framework for Effective Land Administration
